1.4 CONTRACTOR USE OF PREMISES

1.4.1 Use of the Site: Limit use of the premises to work in areas indicated. Confine operations to areas within contract limits indicated. Do not disturb portions of the site beyond the areas in which the Work is indicated.

1.4.1.1 Government Occupancy: Allow for Government occupancy and use by the public.

1.4.1.2 Driveways and Entrances: Keep driveways and entrances serving the premises clear and available to the Government, the Government's employees, and emergency vehicles at all times. Do not use these areas for parking or storage of materials. Schedule deliveries to minimize space and time requirements for storage of materials and equipment on-site.

1.4.2 Use of the Existing Building: Maintain the existing building in a weather tight condition throughout the construction period. Repair damage caused by construction operations. Take all precautions necessary to protect the building and its occupants during the construction period.

1.5 OCCUPANCY REQUIREMENTS

1.5.1 Full Government Occupancy: The Government will occupy the site and existing building during the entire construction period in accordance with the phasing. Cooperate with the Government during construction operations to minimize conflicts and facilitate government usage. Perform the Work so as not to interfere with the Government's operations.

1.6 MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

1.6.1 Government will furnish utilities. Contractor is responsible for all temporary connections to utilities

and any damage the contractor's operations cause to the Government equipment and facilities.

1.6.2 During construction the Contractor will have use of Elevator No. 1. Elevator No. 2 shall be maintained for the exclusive use of the residents.
